

## Tasmanian eSchool Registration/Enrolment Criteria

The Tasmanian eSchool provides a full education program using blended learning which offers a range of learning opportunities, e.g. online, face-to-face, community and home, to achieve curriculum diversity and to promote student engagement. Students can be registered or enrolled with the Tasmanian eSchool under the criteria outlined below:

### Registration procedures at the Tasmanian eSchool

Registered students can be full-time or part-time. Students remain enrolled full time with their 'base' school and access Tasmanian eSchool teachers and programs on a fee-for-service basis. Procedures vary according to the criterion under which the student is registering. A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) detailing responsibilities of all parties is signed at the time the student commences at the eSchool. The five criteria and their procedures are:

Criteria	Definition	Procedure
<b>Pregnancy Registration</b>	A student who is pregnant, with written medical advice. Such registrations may be extended into the post-natal period.	Referral from the school where the student is currently enrolled.
<b>Medical-Psychological Registration</b>	Medical/Psychological Registered students remain enrolled full time with their 'base' school and access Tasmanian eSchool teachers and programs on a fee-for-service basis.	Students can be registered under this criterion if they have an assessment/report from a School Psychologist, other Psychologist or Psychiatrist. Approval of the Learning Services General Manager is also required.
<b>Medical (Other) Registration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) A student who has written medical advice that attendance at school is inadvisable.</li> <li>b) A student who has a disability or need for special support.</li> </ul>	Students can be registered under this criterion if they have an appropriate medical referral from a medical practitioner. Approval of the Learning Services General Manager is also required.
<b>Travel Registration</b>	A student for whom constant travel away from home is necessary, making enrolment at a local school difficult, or where a local school is not accessible. This refers to the children of itinerant workers and the children of Tasmanian residents who are living in inaccessible areas outside the state for work reasons. Students who are involved in travel for recreational purposes for a minimum of two terms can also be enrolled.	Referral from the school where the student is currently enrolled.
<b>School-Initiated Registration</b>	School Initiated Registered students remain enrolled full time with their 'base' school and access Tasmanian eSchool teachers and programs on a part-time, fee-for-service basis.	Referral from the school where the student is currently enrolled.
